Once a reviewer requests and in time receives the book, please write the review with a general but knowledgeable audience in mind. Reviews run anywhere from 300-900 words, depending on the book/author/topic/reviewer. We do not have a policy about publishing negative reviews. We ask reviewers to keep the audience in mind and to be judicious, clear, kind, appropriate, insightful and concise. Footnotes and reference notes are not included in *Tuesday Tidings* book reviews.
