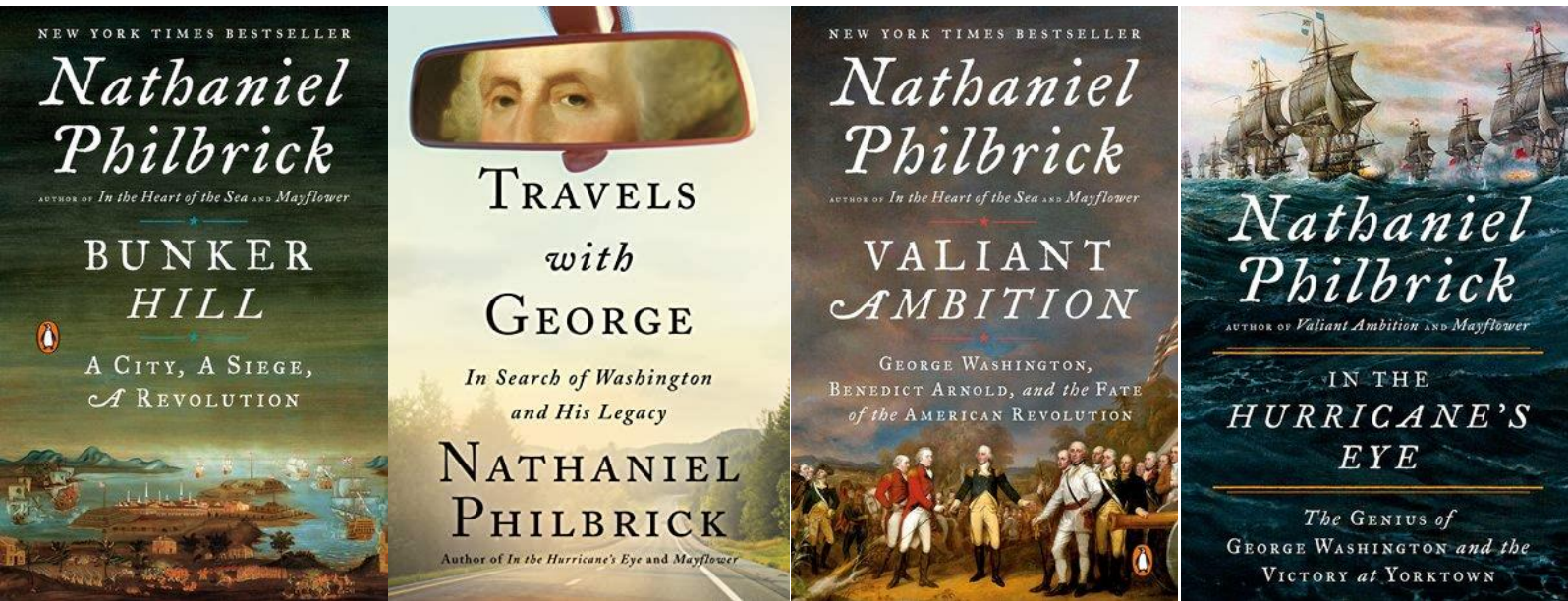

Close to 90 years later, *Dorade* is back on the racing circuit after a full restoration by owners Matt Brooks and Pam Rorke Levy, who were recognized with the 2019 NMHS Distinguished Service Award. The boat has competed with distinction in races to Bermuda, across the Atlantic and the Pacific, and from Sydney to Hobart.

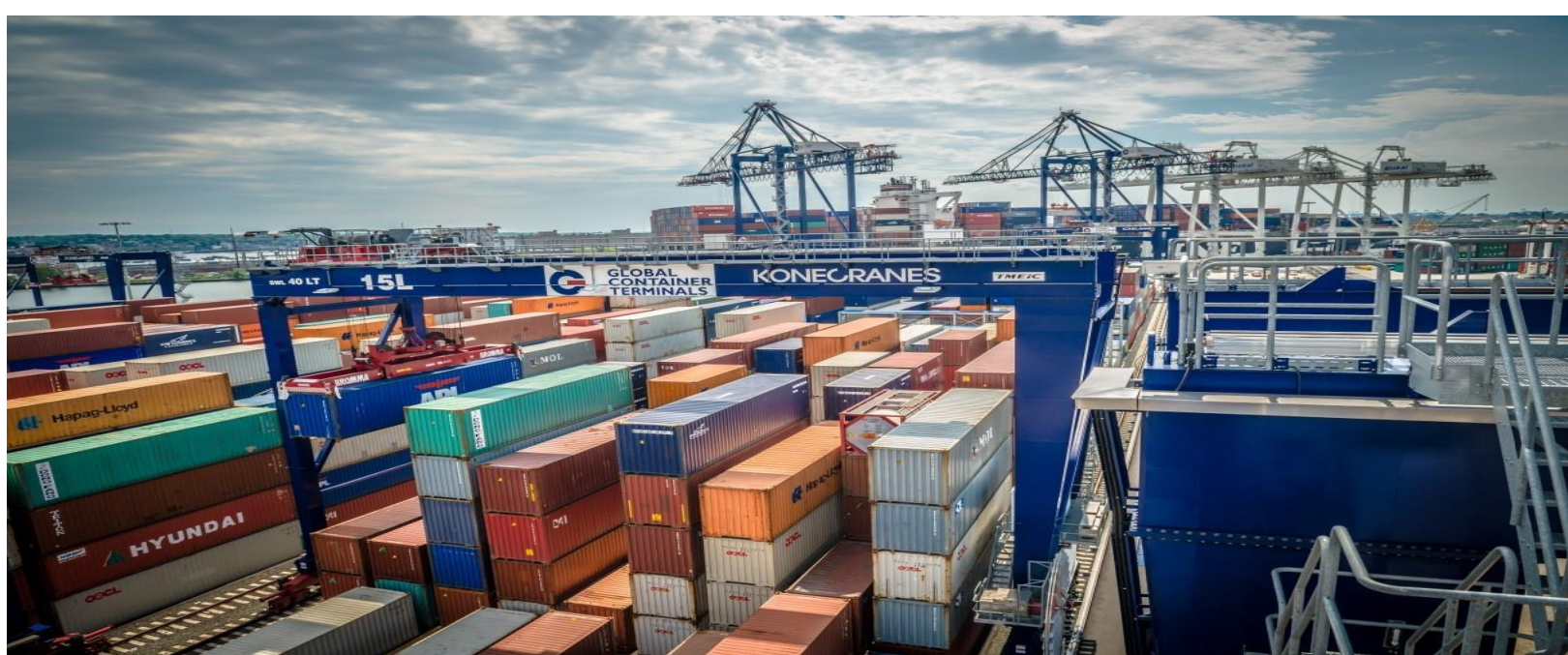

## **HMS *Tenedos* XV — Model from the collection of Bowen Smith**

HMS *Tenedos* (pennant number initially FA4, and later H04) was an Admiralty 'S' class destroyer. Laid down on 6 December 1917, she was constructed by Hawthorn Leslie of Tyne and was completed in 1918. Commissioned in 1919, *Tenedos* served throughout the interwar period. On 5 April 1942, *Tenedos* was sunk with the loss of 33 officers and men by Japanese bombers, while she was under repair at Colombo Harbor. Case size: 26" L x 4.5" W x 7.5" H.

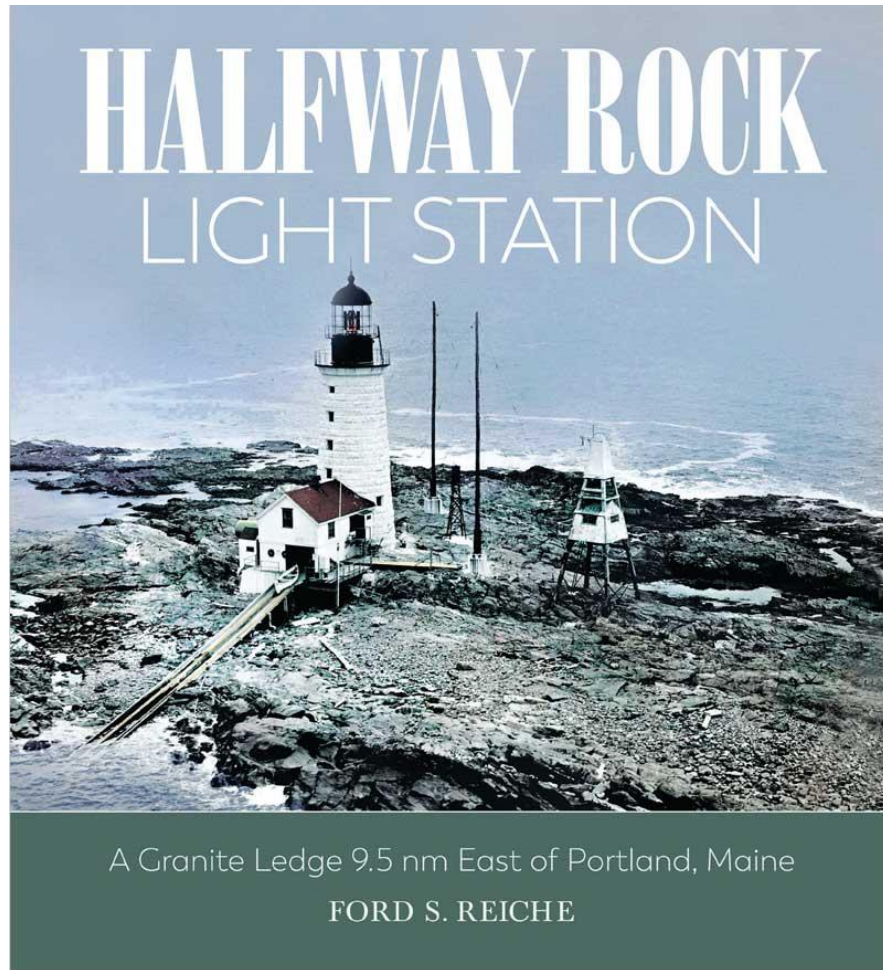

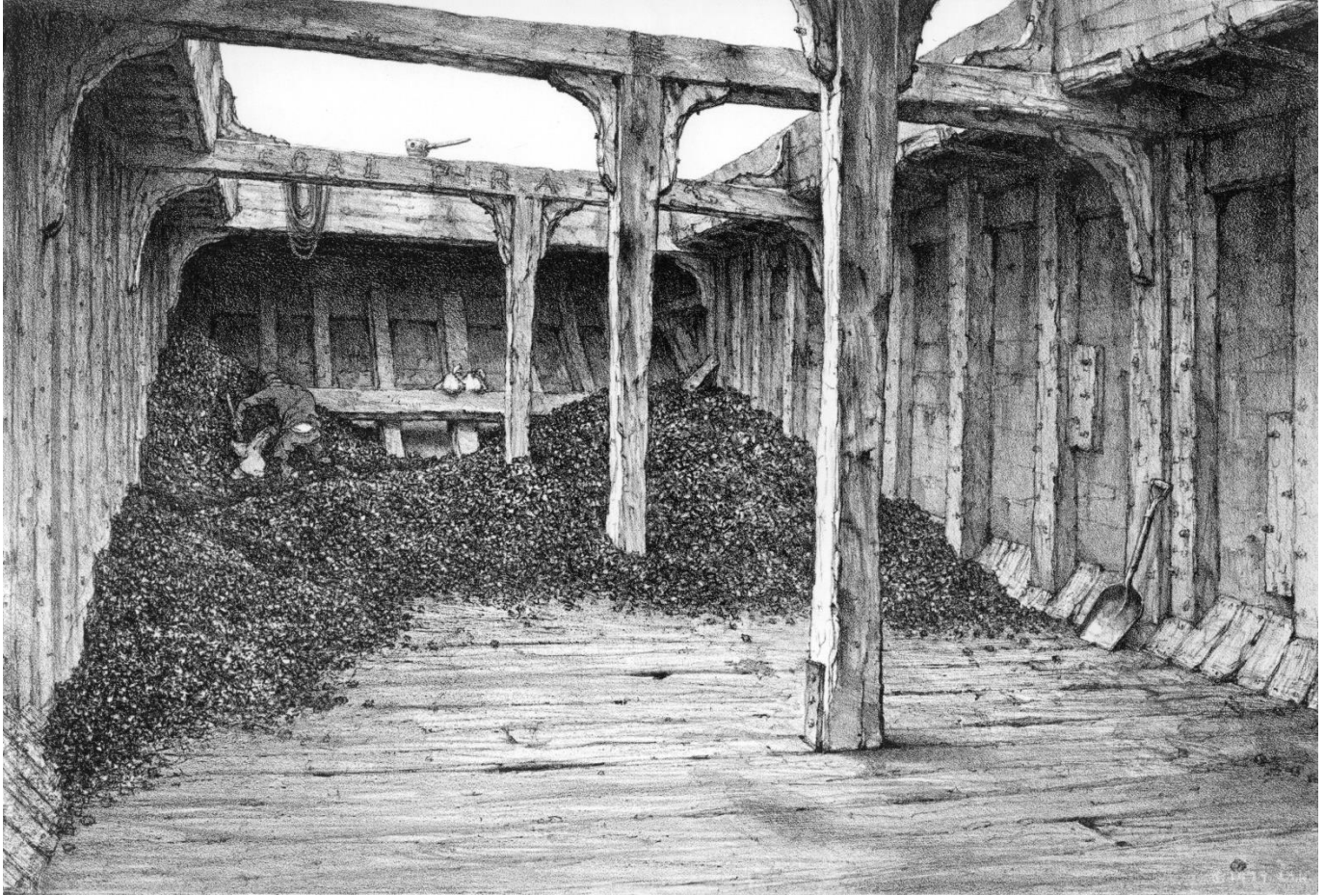
## Ford S. Reiche Signed Book

Perched midway across the mouth of Casco Bay on a barren ledge of two acres, Halfway Rock Light Station is a remote, wave-swept beacon, nearly inaccessible. Built in 1871 to guide mariners approaching Portland Harbor, the lighthouse was manned until it was automated in 1976. Thereafter, maintenance was limited to the bare essentials required to keep the light and foghorn functioning. Declared surplus government property in 2014, Halfway Rock Light Station was offered at auction and purchased by Ford Reiche in 2015. In his book, Reiche surveys the historical background of early light stations and chronicles the lives and duties of lighthouse keepers. He then describes the adventure of restoring the property, with compelling “before and after” photos.
